The German Summer School is a 10-day experience of German language and culture, comprising formal tuition and informal practice, cultural activities (film night, reading night, presentations), sports activities, excursions etc. Teachers and presenters are native speakers and fully qualified and experienced teachers of German.

Who can take part?

If you have some background knowledge of German and wish to extend, improve, or just brush up on your skills, this is the course for you!

Tuition

Three hours daily language tuition in the morning. Classes are offered at different levels - from elementary to very advanced. A placement test ensures that you attend a level which will give you optimal improvement in the correct use of language, reading, writing, grammar and good communication.

Practice

You will have plenty of opportunity to practice your German: the special interest groups in the afternoons will be conducted in German. Topics for the afternoon sessions/activities include

- art and crafts
- drama
- film
- music
- IT
- current affairs
- special sessions for teachers of German.

Excursions

Lilydale is in the foothills of the Dandenong Ranges and we will make the most of this by visiting **Mt. Dandenong** inc. William Rickett Sanctuary, lookout, Olinda shops, **dinner** at the Cuckoo restaurant; **Upper Yarra Dam** via Warburton for a bushwalk and dinner in the bush; **The Yarra Valley**, tasting it's produce (including wine) and dancing the last evening away at Henkell vineyard.

Optional Tour

On the free Sunday we offer this tour to WestgarthTown, a German heritage site, with a visit to the Victoria Market en route. Or you could take the train into the City and check out the sights of Melbourne at your leisure. You could also attend the Australian Tennis Open on that day.
